Time to Prepare for Spring Cleaning!

The City of Edmond has relocated the Recycling Center for more convenient hours. It's located at 3333 Progressive Dr., north of Covell Road and just east of I-35. Recyclable items can be dropped off from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8 a.m. to noon on Saturday.

If it's household hazardous waste you need to dispose of, simply call 800-449-7587 or email hotline@curbsideinc.com to schedule a pickup. You can also dispose of electronic waste too! Give them a call today! To find out more about the program and a list of acceptable items for pick-up, visit edmondok.com.

And for the bulky, larger items, you can take them to the privately-owned transfer station, also located at 3333 Progressive Drive. By dropping off the items you save half the cost of having the items picked up through the monthly bulk collection service. To take advantage of the reduced rate, be sure to bring your most recent Edmond utility bill to show proof of your Edmond residence.

Paying Your Utility Bill Just Got Easier!

The City of Edmond Utility Customer Service department just added another way to pay your utility bill! With UCS Telepay, customers can call in and select the option to pay their bill with this automated system.

"We are always looking for ways to provide more convenience for our customers. We know time is very important and this is just another way to help our customers pay their bill any time, 24 hours a day" said Linda Courtwright, Utility Customer Service Manager.

Here's how it works. First, call the Utility Customer Service number at 359-4541. Customers will hear a short privacy statement and then be asked to select the option for UCS Telepay. Next, customers are then prompted to enter their account number and then to pay their bill. It's just that simple.

Another new feature with this system is customers now have the option to pay with a check through UCS Telepay. Previously, checks were only received in person at the Utility Customer Service office.
